

He's Only Missing
Documentary Screening with Robin Smith
May 8-4:30 pm-GV Square

Join us for this powerful documentary about Robin's father, Lt. Col. Robert Norman Smith, USMC who went missing in August of 1969. When the American POWs were released in 1973 Robin's father was not among them. The absence of information had allowed the possibility of hope. In 1978 Robin produced this film to try to explain what it felt like to live in a state of limbo, never really knowing what happened. Years later, as fragments of what happened began to emerge, a CBS news television crew followed Robin and her husband, Bill Plante as an elderly Viet Cong soldier led them through the jungle to the crash site of her father's plane. The story of that journey "Letting Go" aired in 1995. Robin is an Emmy Award winning producer and Founder and President of Video/Action Fund.

These films are being shown at the DAR Constitution Hall on Wednesday, May 10 as part of the Gold Star Family Film Screenings. Six women have produced documentaries with their family's story. Robin has offered Georgetown Village a screening of her works as a special bonus to our members, volunteers, and donors. Space is limited, rsvp by May 5.

Yayoi Kusama and Hirshhorn Highlights Tour May 11-11:30 am Independence Avenue & 7<sup>th</sup> Street

Georgetown Village has reserved 15 tickets to the Yayoi Kusama exhibit One with Eternity at the Hirshhorn Museum. This exhibit showcases Hirschhorn's permanent collection of works by Kusama, including two of her Infinity Mirror Rooms. For those not familiar with her work, stop by the Village Square and you can see the coffee table book of her work and some prints of her pictures hanging on our walls.
