

## Suggested Questions for Interviewing Home Health Care Providers and Agencies

1. Is the homecare provider licensed?

2. Is the homecare provider accredited by a leading national firm (e.g. ACHC)?

3. Are the caregivers employed by the provider regularly supervised and evaluated by the provider's clinical director or a registered nurse?

4. Does the provider perform criminal background checks on caregivers prior to hiring?

5. Are the caregivers covered by workers' compensation in the event they are injured on the job?

6. Is the provider responsible for deducting state, federal, local, and Social Security taxes from the caregivers' wages?

7. Does the provider send a registered nurse to meet the family and develop a plan of care for the caregivers to follow?

8. Does the provider require the caregivers to carry photo identification?

9. If you are dissatisfied with your caregiver, may you request a replacement?

10. Does the provider keep a "log book" in your home to document services performed (e.g., meals, activities, bathing, etc.)?

12. Is the provider available on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year?

13. Does the provider offer ongoing staff development and training?
