Georgetown Village offers our members:

Access to a Social Worker, contracted by GV, to assist members in evaluating their needs, providing crisis counseling and assisting with after hospitalization placements, and other services.

Health Care Committee chaired by medical professionals offering members monthly information sessions as well as access to information through programming that is recorded for members to access at any time.
